Greetings All,

Last Sunday Silver State hosted a monthly match with their new berms in place. I have to admit it really changed my perception of the Gulch. The match was fast and fun. There were a few glitches but nothing very serious. Target placement, targets, angle of aim, and some backsplash were issues I noticed. Silver StateI was very receptive to suggestions on improvements. I look forward to seeing how they continue to improve the quality of their matches. This is going to be a very good place to shoot. In addition, I held a BBR board meeting last week to discuss how we can help support Silver States range

improvements. It was decided to offer a one time donation of \$500 to help defer some of the cost for the berms. I also reached out to the Silver State board asking if they would allow us to hold monthly matches at the Gulch. I heard back with them giving us the second Saturday & Sunday of the month to hold both a wild bunch match and cowboy match. Not sure if we can do a WB match in July (13th), waiting to hear from Flanagan Flats. We would split the "Gate proceeds" with them for using their range. In addition, Silver State wanted to try holding their own matches on the first Saturday and third Sunday of each month and see if attendance would warrant an additional shoot. If you are interested, please contact any Silver State board member and let them know. Another topic for our board meeting was where we are at on moving, finding a new range, and legal issues the club faces. First order of business was hiring a lawyer to gain access to our personal property out at the racetrack. The owner continues to defer, deflect, and duplicity in negotiations. Working with 49er Preacher, we found a lawyer who specializes in landlord tenant laws. I am done negotiating and turned over all my records of past lease's, rental agreements, and email communications with the owner. The lawyer understands the our goal is to regain possession of our personal property in addition to time needed for the move. Second order was where we are at finding a new range. At this time I am working with a realtor looking at different properties. Have met with her a couple of times looking over some properties a few miles from Silver Springs. These properties are still in the city limits of Fernley. After a looking at property, the realtor has a good idea of what our needs are and is helping to look for more land. I also reached out to the planning department of Fernley to see about land use codes and how we go about changing zoning to accommodate a gun range. This was a Zoom meeting and I asked a number of questions that they will research and send me answers. I also received a message from Fallon Kid about shooting with a club in Fallon. I turned this over to Jasper to follow up on. It might be a viable option while looking for a permeant home. Third order of business was where to move all our equipment when we get access. Jasper has been working hard on this and come up with a number of low cost / no cost options. It will take a bit more time to implement a plan. Hopefully, we can use the no cost option. Time will tell. Next was what I call "Around the Table" where each person in attendance can bring up any new items that need to be discussed. It came up that the club needs a new Treasurer and a HPD Coordinator. If you can help out, please let us know. One of the last items we discussed was the shoot schedule with Silver State. As stated earlier, after hearing from their board we can have the second weekend of the month for BBR monthly's. Last note, doctor okayed me to shoot as long as it was light loads. So Sunday's match was the first time I have been able to shoot in over four months. Can't say I was stellar, but then I never have been. It was good to strap on the guns again and blast away. Only issue I had was with the rifle. Seems operating it caused a cramp in the biceps. I figured the next day would painful but to my surprise it wasn't.

So with that in mind, going on a trip to shoot a match. See you down the trail, Bordello

RO Training

The 8 June April class had 8 shooters attending the RO II course at the Gold Hill. Along with two people auditing the class. Gold Rush, Flanigan and Mark were first time students. The others took the class as a refresher student.

The next RO Course, WBRO, on 20 July 2024 at either the Fernley Library or Gold Hull Hotel or ?? This Wild Bunch course will be entirely in the classroom. We will begin at 9AM and finish by 4PM. This course is IDEAL for all members who shoot Wild Bunch. As with other classes, the student participation is the star of the course. Especially shooters who have taken the class before. PLEASE contact me soon, as the number of members attending will influence the location.

WTC (What's the Call)

Suppose you are in the middle of shooting a stage and "Dang" your firearm jams. After fussing for seamed like minutes (really 5-15 seconds) you declare "Dead Gun" and safely stage the firearm. Once the last shot has been fired. Who takes the declared malfunction firearm to the unloading table?

FIREARM MALFUNCTIONS

In the event a shooter declares a malfunction, the shooter will be given the opportunity to make that firearm safe and continue on with the next procedure. The TO will allow the shooter to make the malfunctioning firearm safe, preferably on a nearby and appropriate horizontal surface (box, table, straw bale, ground, etc.), or **if necessary**, assist the shooter by allowing them to "hand off" the firearm. Multiple malfunctions by a shooter will be cause for the Timer Operator to request the shooter change firearms.

Just to make sure this is clear, the shooter controls who carries the firearm. The shooter may carry the firearm, the TO may offer assistance or the shooter may ask assistance from the TO to "hand off" the firearm. Once at the unloading table, regardless of who transported the gun, it is up to the shooter to decide what to do next. The peanut gallery may offer assistance but NO ONE should assume it is OK for them to handle the gun. The shooter, because of the malfunction firearm, maybe upset, allow them space and in an appropriate manner offer to assist before touching the gun.

FYI, I have seen and heard of several instances where, without permission, someone other than the shooter takes the firearm to the unloading table and begins inspection. THIS IS WRONG!

What are the requirements to be a match official/role

Match Director is in charge of the overall match and is required to ensure qualified officials are in place in all competition areas. The match director is typically the stage writer/designer of the match.

DEPUTY Posse Marshal acts on behalf of the Posse Marshal when the Marshal is shooting or otherwise unavailable. The Marshal & Deputy should be separated in the shooting order for adequate Posse coverage. It is highly recommended that anyone serving in a Posse Marshal or Deputy Posse Marshal capacity be trained in this RO-I Course.

After a brief exchange with Pale Wolf Burnelle, I was surprised to learn that there are NO requirements to be a match official. The highlight above are the only statements regarding requirements. PWB, in his opinion, then comments that the match director should be up-to-date with RO I & RO II courses. Clubs have the option to have their own specific requirements.

Rifle. Three targets, and a knock down target. On the three targets shoot a continuous Nevada sweep for 9 rounds, 10th round on the knock down. The shooter hit each target correctly with the first 6 rounds, Jack's out the 7th round, hit #8 and #9, hits the knock down with the 10th round.

PWB quickly replies and then locks the post.

WTC if in addition to the original post the TO or Spotters say at the end of the rifle "One more round"? The shooter then loads another round and hits where the knockdown was. Now WTC?
